At the **Faculty of Law, Institute of Law and Economics** the position of a

University Professor (W2/W3)

for „**Economics (Law & Economics)**”

is available from April 1st, 2009. (Code/ **Kennziffer 1993**)

The position is intended either for an applicant in his or her first career phase (W2) or for an already experienced scholar (W3). To obtain the higher salary class of W3 Professor the applicant is required to demonstrate an already established international reputation in the indicated field of study.

Knowledge of German is not a necessary pre-requisite for obtaining this position. However, it is expected that after a certain transition period the candidate must be able to teach classes in German language.

The university wishes to increase the number of female professors. Therefore there is great interest in receiving applications from women. In accordance with the Hamburg higher education decree (*Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz*) the applications of women with equal qualifications will be considered preferentially.

Areas of Responsibility

Representation of the subject through research and teaching. The successful candidate will be expected to participate in the joint research programmes of the faculty and their further development. He or she will also be assumed to contribute to the PhD-level study programme in Law and Economics, as well as to the 'European Master Programme in Law and Economics. The teaching load will include basic mandatory and advanced specialised courses in the regular curriculum of the Faculty of Law. Furthermore, the candidate is expected to contribute to the planned interdisciplinary undergraduate and postgraduate study courses that will be offered in cooperation with the economics and social sciences department."

Teaching requirements:

The number of teaching hours is assessed in accordance with the regulation on teaching requirements (*Lehrverpflichtungsverordnung*).

Requirements for employment:

According to § 15 Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz.

The University of Hamburg places special emphasis on the quality of teaching. Therefore applicants must provide proof of teaching experience, and must also submit suggestions on course content.

Severely disabled persons are given preference over candidates not subject to preferential treatment in accordance with the law, where they are equally suitable, able and qualified for the position.
